

I know that you are all trying hard just to maintain some semblance of normalcy during these challenging times. I know how difficult it is to run a program and clinic with all the new regulations that have been put into place.

Dental Hygiene Seminars has been contacted by many dental hygiene students and faculty regarding the 2021 National Board review courses. We have addressed this on our webpage, but I also wanted to share the information with all of you to disseminate to your students.

Dental Hygiene Seminars had been in constant communication with our host hotels for next year. At this point, it is possible that we will be able to do many of our seminars, live, with social distancing. If we are unable to provide live seminars, we will be able to provide the review course to students virtually. We are recording a LIVE seminar, with our regular speakers to a student audience in October. We will use this platform to provide the seminar virtually to those students who cannot attend a live review course.

If students register for a DHS seminar which is not able to provide social distancing, etc. they will be given three options:

- 1) A full refund for the seminar
- 2) A virtual seminar with the 2021 lectures and the review book, which will be mailed prior to seminar. Each seminar “attendee” may view the lectures as many times as needed during the 7 day period allocated to the virtual seminar.
- 3) Purchase the book alone for \$225, sent with free shipping.

I have been contacted by DH faculty whose institutions have restricted students from travelling out of state, or attending any functions that do not provide proper social distancing.
